NOTICE TO INJURED WORKERS

COUNSELOR PROGRAM

Assistance for injured employees is available through the Counselor Program of the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court. Counselors provide the following services:

- Serve as a resource for injured workers, employers and others by providing information about the workers' compensation system.
- Provide information to injured workers, employers, insurance carriers, and health care providers about their responsibilities under the law.
- Provide assistance to injured workers, employers and persons claiming death benefits in obtaining workers' compensation benefits.
- Assist unrepresented claimants, employers and other parties to enable them to protect their rights in the workers' compensation system.

MEDIATION

Mediation services are available to address certain workers' compensation issues without the need for a trial or formal court proceeding. Mediators help parties to a workers' compensation dispute identify issues, clarify misunderstandings, explore solutions and negotiate settlement. Mediation may be voluntary or ordered by the Court. You can contact the Counselor Program for additional information about mediation.
